

Among those from the D-FW area who ventured to far-off marathons over the Dec. 12 weekend, **Brian Edmison**, 35 of Carrollton and **David Hauge**, 49 of Keller, turned in the better times at the **Tucson Marathon**. Edmison ran a 3:19:18 to finish 70th among the 1,075 finishers and Hauge finished in 3:20:31 to finish 75th. Also **Scott Meek**, 41, of Frisco had a 3:40:21 time...At the **Fitness Fiesta Marathon** on Dec. 12 in McAllen, **Abraham Alvarez** of Fort Worth ran a 3:49 and was 23rd among the 115 finishers....Even though the **MetroPCS Dallas White Rock Marathon** boasted 22,000 participants for the Dec. 5 marathon and half marathon, several runners from the Dallas-Fort Worth area traveled to compete at other venues across the country. **Melisa Christian**, 34, of Dallas turned in the fastest time by running a 2:43:47 (all times are chip times if listed) at the **California International Marathon** in Sacramento on Dec. 5. Other top finishers from D-FW included **Scott Manis**, 47, of Richardson (3:09:334); **Mark Wooten**, 30, of Garland (3:11:23); **Manuel Houellemont**, 42 of Plano (3:19:30); **Christopher Wong**, 28, of Addison (3:19:51); **Jayna Henstorf**, 30, of Dallas (3:19:53); **Amanda Schulz** (31), of Dallas (3:22:48); **Kim Dukes**, 41, of Coppell (3:28:22); and **Craig Schacherer**, 45 of Wylie (3:29:08)....At the **Las Vegas Marathon** on Dec. 5 top finishers from D-FW included **Wayne Nielsen** of Fort Worth (3:23:01); **George Hyde** of Plano (3:26:38); **Jon Grutzmacher** of Hurst (3:29:21); **Alan Tharp** of Allen (3:31:27); **Mark Spurlock** of Southlake (3:36:37); **Jeff Wills** of Stephenville (3:37:44); **Kimberly Sulak** of Frisco (3:39:07); and **Sara Robert** of McKinney (3:41:41)....At the **Memphis Marathon** on Dec. 4, **Serene Giffin**, 40, of Roanoke ran a 3:45:24....**Margie Starr Lawrence**, 54, of Plano placed second in her age group with a 3:57:21 at the **Marathon of Palm Beaches** in West Palm Beach, Fla., on Dec. 5....At the **Baton Rouge Beach Marathon** on Dec. 4, **Price Rogers**, 48, of Dallas ran a 3:14:22 to place second in his age division; **Philip Hodge**, 44, of Little Elm earned first in his age division with a 3:23:21; and **Brian Miller**, 38, of Fort Worth was fourth in his age division with a 3:23:59.....**Joe Boyle** has a website (www.texasrunningcenter.com) that serves as a place where runners of all levels can find other groups to train or run with. His running club also organizes and conducts three free training sessions a week at Wimbledon Park in Arlington. Three-time **Cowtown Marathon** winner **Keith Pierce**, 30, who's now living in Cedar Park, was third overall with a 2:23:15....**Michel Morley**, 36, of Dallas traveled to Virginia on Nov. 13 and nailed a BQ time of 3:44:30 at the **Richmond Marathon**....Galveston is

bringing back a marathon after 21 years of its last event. The **Galveston Mardi Gras Marathon & Half Marathon** is scheduled Feb. 20 in 2011. [See the website](#) for more information...**Laura Nelson**, 44, had successful back-to-back efforts on Saturday evening (Oct. 16) and then on Sunday morning. Laura, 44, of Grapevine won the **Firefly Run 5K** in Plano in 19:10.83 and on Sunday morning won the **FWRC's Mercury 10K** in 40:02....Two runners from the D-FW area won the first **Tyler Rose Marathon** on Oct. 10. **Kiplimo Chemirmir**, 27, of Flower Mound won the men's title in 2:44:34 and **Melisa Christian**, 33, won the female title in 2:54:15. There were 245 finishers, including 142 males and 103 females....At the **ING Hartford Marathon** on Oct. 9, **Bill Berenson**, 55, of Fort Worth had suffered a cracked rib the day before the marathon (though he didn't know it was cracked at the time), but still ran a 3:39:34. He started out holding an ice bag on his chest, and still managed a third place in his age group and a 15th consecutive Boston Marathon (BQ) qualifying time...At the **Steamtown Marathon** in Scranton, PA, on Oct. 10, there were several BQs and fast times, including **Roger Clifford**, 43, of Plano with a 2:52:17 and second place in his age division; **Troy Pruett**, 49, of North Richland Hills with a 2:57:23, good for third in his age division; **Joshua Thompson**, 36, of Plano with a 2:58:47; **Jeff Dorrill**, 49, of Dallas with a 3:18:35; **Tom Anthony**, 50, of Dallas with a 3:35:53; **Michael Underwood**, 26, of Denton with a 3:39:21; **Roberto Ruiz**, 47, of Dallas with a 3:43:41 and **Roger Hale**, 54, of Sherman with a 3:47:30....Several other runners went to various marathons over the Oct. 9-10 weekend. At the **Run Mother Road Marathon** in Joplin, MO, **Jerry Going**, 29, of Frisco ran a 3:22:28 to place 14th among the 522 finishers; **Ron Bouchard**, 44, of The Colony ran a 3:37:11; **Phillip Dow**, 31, of Little Elm posted a 3:46:32; and **Amber Boley**, 31, of Wylei, finished in 3:49:30.... **Ernesto Caballero**, 45, of Dallas hasn't lost too many steps since he won **The Cowtown Marathon** in 1993. At the **Twin Cities Marathon** in Minneapolis/St. Paul on Oct. 3, Ernesto ran a 2:38:53 to place 80th among the 8,211 finishers. When he won Cowtown, he ran a 2:34:58. Also logging good times at the Twin Cities were **Ryan Kaiser**, 31, of Dallas with a Boston-qualifying 2:58:41; **Landon White**, 31, of Dallas with a 3:13:55; **Alison Lueck**, 25, of Dallas, with a Boston-qualifying 3:29:13; **Robert Benson**, 60, of Dallas with a Boston-qualifying 3:33:27; **Charlie Hart**, 54, of Arlington with a BQ 3:34:40; **Thomas Okazaki**, 53, of Southlake with a BQ 3:35:24; **Amy Ewing**, 41, of Fort Worth with a BQ 3:35:43; and **Megan Knauss**, 26, of Dallas with a 3:42:30...At the **St. George (Utah) Marathon** on Oct. 2, **David Jones**, 39, of Dallas was 444th overall among the 5,697 finishers with a 3:18:58. Other top finishers from the DFW area included **Mark Westerheide**, 50, of Mansfield with a BQ 3:28:14; **Arnulfo Sanchez III**, 39, of McKinney with a 3:29:22; **Beth Bedell**, 31, of Dallas with a BQ 3:33:39; and **Travis Reeves**, 33, of Frisco with a 3:34:46....Several DFW area runners ventured to Odessa on Oct. 2 to run the **West Texas Cross Roads Marathon**. The top two finishers from the area were **Lauren Woolley**, 30, of Plano with a 3:53:47 and **Jessica Northup**, 30, of McKinney with a 3:54:04....Among the runners who ventured out of state over the Sept. 18, two recorded impressive finishes. **Richard Humphrey**, 48, of Keller ran a 3:23:34 at the **Air Force Marathon** in Dayton, Ohio, on Sept. 18 to place 121st among the 2,416 finishers, and he earned a Boston Marathon qualifying time....At the **Bismark (N.D.) Marathon** on Sept. 18, **Michael Smith**, 47, of Coppell finished in 3:29:08 and was 17th among the 199 finishers. The time earned him a Boston qualifying time....**James Jackson**, whose many road race victories include the Cowtown 10K in 1992 in 30:19, started the **Showdown Cross Country Series** on Sept. 12 at Corinth Community Park in Corinth. The series goes through Nov. 14 and includes a 1-mile fun run, a 2-mile run and a 5K. The 2-mile and 5K will be timed and medals awarded. Former LGRAW president **K2 Richards**, 41, ran a 3:44:53 at the **Heart of America Marathon** in Columbia, Mo., on Sept. 6 and was second in her age division. **Peter Beauvais**, 49, of De Soto nailed his BQ at the **American Discovery Trail Marathon** in Colorado Springs on Sept. 6 with a 3:27:49, good for third in his age division. At the **Tupelo (Miss.) Marathon** on Sept 5, **Serene Griffin**, 40, of Roanoke, ran a BQ 3:16:28 to place second in her age division, and **Ed Kopiak**, 68, of Fort Worth finished in 4:15.55 at the **Turtle Marathon** in Roswell, N.M., on Sept. 6 to earn a BQ. Another who finished relatively high in a marathon that weekend was **Susan Autry**, 27, of Weatherford with a 3:53.25 at the **Kauai Marathon** in

Hawaii on Sept. 5....Several D-W area brave souls tackled the **Pikes Peak Marathon** on Aug. 22, and **Wes Ritner**, 42, of Dallas led the way with a 6:02:38 (the course includes a trek up and down the peak). He was the 145th finisher among the 688 who successfully completed the test. Other from the D-FW area included **John Noltensmeyer**, 41, of Dallas in 6:05:42; **Bob Smeby**, 53, of Plano in 6:22:13; **Larry Lichnovsky**, 62, of Arlington (6:24:22); **Barbara Schultz**, 40, of Allen (6:28:48); **Claudia P. Zulejkic**, 39, of Rockwood (6:45:26) and **David Zulejkic**, 42, (7:04:49)....**Daniel Russey**, male winner of the 39-under division at the **Trinity 5000 Summer Series**, said he's training for his first marathon, the **Metro PCS Dallas White Rock** on Dec. 5. He plans to test himself at half that distance at the **Heels, Hills and Him** on Sept. 26 in Irving....If they don't have a frequent flyer's mileage deal, they should get one. At least five D-FW area runners traveled to Anchorage, Alaska, on Aug. 15 to run either the **Big Wild Life Marathon and Half Marathon**. In the half, **Cary Hancock**, 48, of Hurst ran a 2:01:59.6, son **Layne**, 20, finished in 2:18:42.1 and **Whitney Wakefield**, a former cross country teammate of Layne's at Birdville High, finished with Layne in 2:18:42.1. She now lives in McGregor. In the **Big Wild Life Marathon**, **Jack Becker**, 64, of Dallas, ran a 3:40:06.4 and **Bill Berenson**, 55, of Fort Worth finished in 3:45:48.5. Berenson, nursing an injured hamstring, still managed to log is 14th consecutive Boston Marathon-qualifying time in the past 18 months while placing second in his age division. Berenson said he also had to avoid an enormous moose and her calf during the run. Now, that's something you don't see around D-FW. Also, **Tim Egoft**, 42, of Frisco finished in 4:42:27....The 35th **Trinity Trot**, scheduled Oct. 2, has moved this year to its original location at TCU. The 4-mile run has been at Trinity Park and at Bellaire and Hulen the past few years.The **Mud Run DFW** has been turned into a two-day event on Nov. 6-7 because of the increase in participation. The competitive and kids race are scheduled for the 7th....**Dawn Burke** of Dallas won the women's masters title at the **Run, Walk and Roll 5K** at Reverchon Park on Saturday morning (Aug. 14), and it was an early birthday present for her. She is 49, but is ready to move to the 50-54 age division. A big birthday bash was planned for her in the evening at **Bob Luchsinger's** home....For those runners looking for prize money, there are a few races that offer cash incentives. In September, for example, the **Addison Oktoberfest** (Sept. 14) is offering \$250 for the overall male and female winners; \$100 for second and \$50 for third. Overall masters winners can earn \$100. On Oct. 2, the **Clark Gardens Half Marathon, 5K**, is offering \$100 for overall half winners. Also, on Oct. 9, the **Lake Joe Pool Pumpkin Run** is offering \$100 to overall winners...Even though the temperature was about 100 on Thursday night (Aug. 5) at the **Trinity 5000 Summer Series**, **Mark Followill** ran a 5K personal best of 19:38, beating his previous best, he said, by 12 seconds and winning the 35-39 age division. "I'm surprised," he said. However, he added, "I'm paying for it," as he had a difficult time cooling down as it took several minutes before he began feeling better....**Chad Cook**, 33, of Dallas was the fastest Metroplex finisher at the **San Francisco Marathon** on July 25 with a 3:11:27. Also, **Winston Hurst**, 18, of Dallas was among the top finishers with a 3:34:26....At the **Carrollton (MI) Festival of Races** on July 25, **Bobby Brown**, 54, of Carrollton (TX) ran a Boston qualifying time of 3:15:14....**Chris Crawford**, 49, of Dallas ran another fast time for the second consecutive month by posting a 3:14:26 at the **University of Okoboji Marathon** in Iowa on July 17. He placed fifth. **Jim Mayo**, 60, of Coppell, won his age division with a 3:43:15 and nailed a Boston qualifying time. Also, **John Little**, 63, of Coppell bagged himself a Boston qualifying time of 3:55:16....The **MetroPCS Dallas White Rock Marathon** will be offering \$25,000 in prize money for the marathon on Dec. 12....**Bill Berenson**, 55, of Fort Worth celebrated Independence Day by running the **Foot Traffic Flat Marathon** in Portland, OR., and was rewarded with his fifth Boston Marathon-qualifying time, which he has posted in five states and within five months. He ran a 3:39:39, but that wasn't the end of his activities. The race was on Sunday (July 4) and two days later he was skiing down Mount Hood in the morning and playing golf that evening in Washington. On July 3, a few D-FW area runners finished the difficult **Leadville Trail Marathon** in Colorado, where the course that includes old miners trails and peaks at 13,185 feet. The average finish time among the 327 who crossed the line was 6 hours, 16 minutes and 49 seconds. Leading the way from the D-FW area was **Richard Humphrey**, 48, of Keller with a 5:35:10, which was good for 83rd place. **Philip Williams**, 37, came in at 5:59:05 and **Jerry Hodges**, 40, of Frisco finished in 6:00:22....**Mitch Kent**, 44, of Southlake was 201st among the 4,080 finishers at the **Rock 'n' Roll**

Seattle Marathon on June 26 with a 3:26:49. Among other top finishers from the D-FW area were **Carrie Seeley**, 35, of Mansfield with a Boston Marathon-qualifying 3:43:01 and **Read Hoffman**, 24, of Irving with a 3:44:27. At the difficult and hot **Running With The Devil Marathon** in Boulder City, Nev., on June 26, **Matt Riley**, 36 of Denton came in with a 5:00:54 and **Kyle Wood**, 25, of Dallas finished in 5:02:21. The average finishing time was 6:07:51....Also, in a grueling event that started on June 26, three Metroplex ultra marathoners finished the **100-mile Western States Endurance Run**, which includes a cumulative climb of 13,185 feet and a total descent of 13,185 feet. **Cindy Melder**, 48, of Dallas finished in 27:39:17. b, 63, Fort Worth, came in at 29:39:42 and **Fred Thompson**, 61, Keller, finished a step behind at 29:39:41. There were 328 finishers.....Anchorage is a long way to go from D-FW, but three area runners made the journey and were among those who finished relatively high at the June 19 **Mayor's Marathon**. **Jon Korte** of Grapevine ran a Boston Marathon-qualifying time of 3:12:51 and placed 33rd among the 851 finishers and eighth in the 40-44 age division. **Douglas Keeffe** of Grapevine also nailed a Boston qualifier with a 3:45:05 and was 10th in the 55-59 age division. **Mark Hapka** of Dallas beat four hours with his 3:56:53 and was 22nd in the 25-29 division....**Chris Crawford**, of Dallas zipped to a 3:17:58 to place third overall and second in his 40-49 age division in the marathon race at the **Niagara Ultra 50K, Marathon and Half** at Ontario, Canada on June 19. Crawford, 49, was coming off a fourth place finish on May 30 at the Andy Payne Marathon, where he ran a 3:02:52....**Bill Berenson**, 55, of Fort Worth continues his amazing marathon feats despite logging only 25 miles a week. He ran his 12th consecutive Boston Marathon-qualifying time in 12 different states at the **North Olympic Discovery Marathon** in Port Angeles, Wash., on June 6. He ran a 3:38:45, his fourth BQ in the past four months. He said he has been trying to beat 3:30, but his hopes faded when he encountered "two monster hills" at miles 16 and 20. At the **Rock 'n' Rolle Marathon** in San Diego on June 6, three D-FW area runners finished high among the 10,625 finishers. **Richard Sullivan**, 29, of Dallas, ran a 3:18:16;**Nick La Barbera**, 47, of Richardson posted a 3:28:59; and **Christina Hughes Babb**, 35, of Dallas ran a 3:31:21. At the **Sunburst Marathon** in South Bend, Ind., on June 5, **Jeff Garber**, 45, of Lewisville zipped to a 3:00:15 to win his age division and place eighth among the 744 finishers. On June 6, **Angela Tortorice**, 42, of Dallas finished the **Steamboat Marathon** in Steamboat Springs, Colo., in 5:12:23. **Jeff Venable**, 54, of Dallas, traveled to **Casper, Wy.**, to run that city's marathon on June 6 and finished in 4:50:21. Then at the **Lewis and Clark Marathon** in Bozeman, Mont., on June 6, **Peter Beauvais**, 48, of Desoto won his age division with a 3:24:05 and was sixth among the 70 finishers....A lottery system has been put in place for the **Chevron Houston Marathon and Aramco Houston Half Marathon**. This will give all runners the same chance to register for the Jan. 30, 2011, events. Last year, the event sold out in 60 hours....Runners can enter the lottery by registering between 6 a.m., July 27, and 11:59 p.m., Aug. 12. Officials will announce participants on Tuesday, Aug. 17. Runner-up was **Ethan Doherty** of Boerne Champion, just a step behind at 4:08.09.
